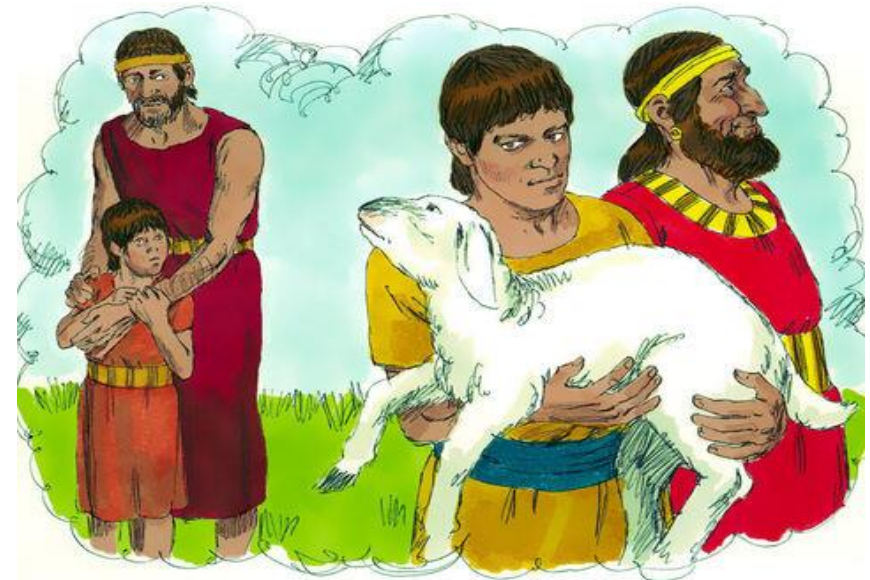
David Is Sorry
